SAFETY FORUM

Moderator – Roberto Fuenzalida

Roberto came from Chile (married to a lady from Argentina) at mid-life in 1969 and later took up his dream to be a pilot. He now owns a newly acquired airplane, a Navion.

He first reminded us about how free we are in the United States, something that we mostly take for granted. He related his first aviation experience in Bhutan (India) where, according to Roberto: *"in Bhutan it was very challenging to fly between the two mountains."*

He presented the details of a complete pre-flight inspection, including the interior of the aircraft. The condition of the pilot was included, especially of the concern for recent consumption of alcohol or the use of medications. He cited some examples of the consequences of being interrupted during a preflight and the likely failure to notice a problem.

In summary, Roberto emphasized this: *"It's very important not to be distracted during the preflight inspection. Double check everything!"*

We must look out for each other---an MDPA "safety culture."

MDPA DINNER MEETING, FRIDAY, JULY 15 2016, 6:30PM

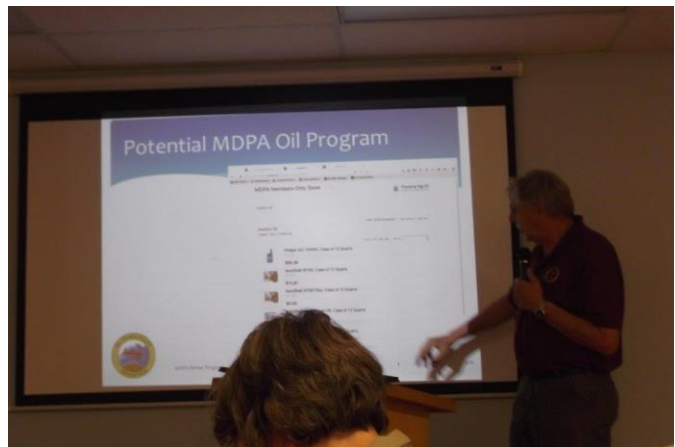
